

Beginning in March I plan to share a set of Sunday sermons from the Book of Isaiah. Three words sum up my reasons for choosing Isaiah for our next preaching series. The first word is *balance*. God wants us to study and learn from all of the Bible, not just a few favorite books in it, and Isaiah might be a Bible book that we haven't spent much time reading lately. The second word is *relevance*. Isaiah lived in a time when his nation had strayed far from God and was in serious risk of divine judgment. America's situation is pretty much the same today, so Isaiah's message rings as true for us as it did for ancient Israel. The third word is *hope*. Although Isaiah's task was to warn his people that judgment was right around the corner, God also used him to communicate a message of encouragement to those who chose to repent and return to following God in obedience, and we need that same reassurance as we go all-out to follow Jesus in our declining culture.

So, I invite you to attend every Sunday in this exciting series. Also, consider reading through the Book of Isaiah now, in order to become freshly acquainted with that grand part of Scripture. I promise you that doing those things will be time well spent!
