

COVID-19: WORSHIP GATHERING GUIDELINES

The following measures and guidelines will be followed in order to limit attendees' potential exposure to the virus as much as possible:

- Ushers will be posted at the front entrance to the Worship Center to count attendees, and we will designate specific exits for people to use when each service concludes. Our maximum seating capacity is 140 persons per service which is 20% of our maximum occupancy.
- Every other row in the Worship Center will be cordoned off, in order to create more space between rows from back to front. Cordoned-off rows will be rotated between the two services.
- Hand sanitizer will be available, and doorknobs, bathroom faucets, and other commonly-touched surfaces in the Worship Center will be sanitized by a team of volunteers between services.
- Attendees are required to wear face masks.
- We will not be able to provide childcare for any of the worship services, and Children's Church will not be held until further notice.
- We will place offering boxes at six locations in the Worship Center into which offerings may be placed on Sundays. This will avoid the necessity of handling offering plates that are touched by many people. (Offerings may still be dropped off in Building B during the week as many have done during the shutdown.)
- We will forgo the fellowship time during the services.
- We ask that family units sit together, with at least three seats between family units, until further notice.
- We ask that all persons follow the normal social-distancing guidelines, including maintaining at least 6 feet between yourself and persons who are not members of your household.
