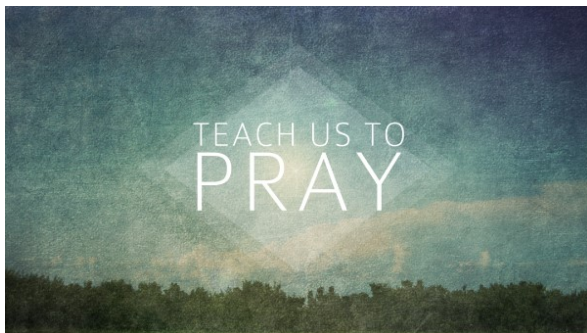


Questions about this Sunday's Message: "HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME"



TEACH US TO PRAY. Here are some questions for you to reflect upon as you prepare your heart and mind to hear the second message in the series on Sunday, October 18. These questions are not to be submitted to the church but are only to get you thinking.

1. Do you include a time of praising God in your prayers?
 2. What do you suppose Jesus meant by the words "hallowed be your name" in the Lord's Prayer?
 3. Why might the time in your prayers (at the beginning, middle, or ending) that you praise God matter? How does praising God effect other things you include in your prayers?
 4. What are other benefits of including praise to God in your prayers?

Read Matthew 6:9-13 and reflect upon why Jesus teaches us to include each part of the Lord's Prayer in our own prayers to God?
