I invite you to visit blesseveryhome.com and check it out. Once there, you can click on “Be a Light” and watch a short

video that explains the concept and tells how you can become involved. Participation is confidential and free of charge. To enroll, go to blesseveryhome/signup.

I have enrolled in it, and every morning I receive in my inbox a link that takes me to a list of my neighbors who live on my street and nearby streets. I pray for them by name, and then click “Done.” It’s that easy! Of course, I am praying for God to open doors for me to share the light of Christ and the Gospel with them.

This seven-week study will examine the historical and cultural climate of first-century Middle Eastern society not only to understand Jesus more deeply but to fuel your worship of Him today.
