

Questions about this Sunday's Message: "OUR FATHER"



TEACH US TO PRAY. Here are some questions for you to reflect upon as you prepare your heart and mind to hear the first message in the series on Sunday, October 11. These questions are not to be submitted to the church but are only to get you thinking.

1. Do you begin your prayers with the words, "Dear Heavenly Father" or something similar? Why?
 2. If you prayed to Jesus or to the Holy Spirit, do you think God would hear your prayers?
 3. Jesus and the Holy Spirit are God, just as the Father is God, so does it make any difference which member of the Trinity we direct our prayers to?
 4. If it is correct to pray to the Father, do Jesus and the Holy Spirit have any involvement in our prayers at all?
 5. If you don't know how to express your thoughts or feelings to God in prayer, does He still understand what you mean?

Read Matthew 6:5-13 and reflect upon what Jesus teaches about prayer.
